2021 4-H Chick Chain

The 4-H Chick Chain is a great way for youth to gain skills in the areas of animal science, poultry, responsibility and personal development. The 4-H youth will get 12 baby chicks (Australorps) in March/April (tentative delivery date to be set). They will raise the baby chicks and if we are able to hold a sale the youth will bring three (3) of them back to the 4-H Chick Chain Sale (this is tentative due to status of Coronavirus).

Requirements for the 4-H Chick Chain

The cost is \$40 for 12 birds.

There will be an orientation (virtual, required) in March for those participating.

You will keep a record book related to this project.

Extension Agent will make one or more home visits to check on the progress of the birds.

You are to bring back 3 birds to the 4-H Chick Chain Sale (if able to hold a sale).

At this time, we do not know the status of the Hamilton County Fair. If the Fair is held you are to volunteer for a minimum of 3 hours at the Poultry tent at the Fair and be present for the 4-H Chick Chain Sale (adults are encouraged to be present during volunteer time as well).
