The Quilt: Xs and Os

We'll be making the Missouri Star Xs and Os quilt pattern. This pattern uses Charm Packs (precut 5" squares) or you can cut your own. It's great as either a scrappy look or a very deliberate Xs and Os pattern.

You will be responsible for purchasing your quilting fabric.

Material List:

Quilt Size 68" x 77"

4 pkg. (42 ct) 5" print squares
2 pkg. (42 ct) 5" white squares
Inner border ¾ yd
Outer border 1½ yd
Binding ¾ yd
Backing 4 ¾ yd

What Happens at 4-H Quilt Camp?

You will learn quilting skills and develop a love of quilting that you can enjoy for a lifetime. This will be a full day of learning quilting skills and making your quilt blocks. You will make a sample to learn the finishing techniques. Tutorials will be available to assist you in finishing your quilt. We will follow up each class with a virtual zoom/in-person class to help you finish your quilt.

What to expect:

- Hands-on classes making quilt blocks and learning piecing techniques.
- Make the quilt blocks for your quilt top.
- Complete a sample block to learn machine quilting and binding.
- Help make a Quilt of Valor for someone who has served our country.
- Meet new friends, enjoy sewing experiences and just have FUN!
- Learn how to select fabrics, patterns & quilt designs.
- Learn different methods of quilting.
- Talk to quilt experts and see examples of their quilts.

Qualifications:

- 6th grade -12th grade as of Jan 1, 2021
- Be able to use a sewing machine independently
- Be able to make an even ¼" allowance
- Have a sewing machine at home to complete your quilt.
