Archery Club -Grades 4th-12th learn archery basics and practice skills once a month in fall and twice a month in spring on Saturdays at Chester Frost Park in Hixson during the school year. Citizenship Club – Grades 4th-12th participate in 4-H activities, as well as learn more about their community, country, and world. Leadership, STEM activities, and community service are emphasized. Lots of opportunities to participate in 4-H contests are offered. Gardening Club – Grades 4th-8th learn about plant and soil science and insects. Activities are led by Master Gardeners. Meets at the Extension office on two Thursdays of each month 4:30-6:00 p.m. during summer and once a month in fall. Remaining summer meetings are July 6 and July 20, 2023 at 4:30 p.m.

Horse Club – Grades 4th-12th with an interest in horses or veterinary science can join the Mane Attraction 4-H Horse Club. Club meets at Saddle Pals Riding Club, Smith Morgan Rd, in Soddy Daisy on the first Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. Owning a horse is not required.
