4-H Junior CampJune 10-14

Grades 4th through 6th

Enjoy swimming, water slide, Gaga ball, archery and rifle ranges, fishing, arts and crafts, camp carnival night, wildlife and fossils room, zipline and ropes course, tie-dyeing, airbrushing, canoeing, woodworking, and cookouts. Plus, this year's special programs at junior camp include drones and robotics, and a show about birds of prey!

Registration has been extended through May 22, or until full. The **Clyde Austin 4-H Center** is an ACA (American Camp Association) accredited facility with modern, air-conditioned lodging, dining, and recreation buildings. The camp staff serve homecooked meals - the summer camp menu includes pizza, chicken nuggets, taco night, spaghetti night, and more youth favorites.

Camp registration fee is \$360, which includes transportation to

camp, food, lodging, activities, and a camp t-shirt.
